Royals

King Henrys Escape (Captive King freed by his son at Evesham)

Lord Edwards Rise (Prince Edward who led the royal army, made his name at Evesham by freeing his dad)

Roger de Mortimers Way (Price Edwards main man)

Gilbert de Clares Way (another of Price Edwards main men)

De Beauchamps Close (leading local royal knight)

John de Warennes Walk (leading royal knight)

Rebels

De Montforts End (founder of representative parliament and leader of the rebel barons killed at Evesham)

Nicholas Seagraves Turn (was one of de Montfort's main men - turn-coated onto the royal side)

Walter de Cantilupes Grove (Bishop of Worcester, major role in the Battle)

Hugh de Despencers Place (leading rebel baron)

Giles d Argentains Park (leading rebel baron)

John Fitzjohns Place (leading rebel baron)
